Scholarship and Fellowship

PURPOSE:

The Chinese American Citizen Alliance-Albuquerque Lodge wishes to recognize and reward the youth members for their participation in the Chinese American Citizens Alliance-Albuquerque Lodge activities and their academic achievement.

AWARD PROCESS:

The scholarship or fellowship will be awarded on an annual basis. A scholarship committee (minimum 3 members) has been appointed by the board of directors. The committee will make the applications available subject to review by the board of Directors. The scholarship committee will then review all applications and present their top recommendations to the Board of Directors. The three finalists will be chosen from this group.

QUALIFICATIONS:

The applicants must meet the following requirements:

- A. The applicant must be between 16 and 25 years of age on the application date.
- B. The applicant cannot have received more than three prior Chinese American Citizens Alliance-Albuquerque Lodge scholarship or fellowship finalist Awards.
- C. The applicant or the applicant's parents **must be an active member** of the Chinese American Citizens Alliance-Albuquerque Lodge.
- D. The award must be used for tuition, room and board, or books and supplies for enrollment into a post-secondary educational facility.

AWARDS:

The amount (subject to change by committee) of the awards will be given at the discretion of the Board. Awards: 1st prize: \$1000, 2nd prize: \$750 3rd prize: \$500; Honorable Mention Awards.
